Sub: Amendment to the Ordinance for Constitution of School Board - Reg.

To fulfill the mandate of the University and as per the provisions of the University Act, the University established Off-Campuses across the States of the Country. To make it more inclusive in any kind of decision making process, it is being proposed to have proper representation of off-campus institutions. Therefore the In-charge/ Principal of the concerned Off-campus is being nominated as member of the respective School Boards.

The amendment to Ordinance for Constitution of the School Board under Statute 16 (2) of Clause (1) is proposed as follows: -

Clause (1): The following shall be members of the School Board: -

- i) Dean of the School concerned;
- ii) All Heads of Departments under the school concerned;
- iii) All Professors in the School concerned;
- iv) Senior-most Reader / Associate Professor or equivalent cadre in each Department by rotation;
- v) Senior-most Lecturer / Assistant Professor or equivalent cadre in each Department by rotation;
- vi) Two Professors from other Schools nominated by the Vice Chancellor;
- vii) Three external members to be nominated by the Vice Chancellor for a period three years;

viii) In-charge/Principal of concerned Off-campus

Clause (2): The Dean of the School concerned shall be Chairperson;

Clause (3): Fifty percent of the members shall form the quorum for the meeting.

Sub: Amendment to the Ordinance for Constitution of Board of Studies (BoS) - Reg.

A proper representation of faculty of respective disciplines of off-campus institutions is being proposed for effective transfer and implementation of the decisions of BoS.

The following amendment to Ordinance for Constitution of the Board of Studies under Statute 17(2) Clause (1) is proposed as follows: -

Clause (1): The Board of Studies (BoS) shall consist of the following members namely: -

- i) All teaching staff of the Departments concerned;
- ii) Two external members to be nominated by the Vice Chancellor for the period of (3) years;
- iii) One Teaching Staff from the Off Campus in respective discipline nominated by the Vice Chancellor on rotation basis;
- Clause (2): The Head of Department concerned shall be the Chairman of such BoS;
- Clause (3): Fifty percent of the members shall form the quorum for the meeting;
